Adult Advisors for 2010 Presbyterian Youth Triennium  
GUIDELINES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Be someone who lives out his/her Christian faith.
2. Be an active participant in a Presbyterian Church in the Presbytery of West Virginia church as an active member, youth director, church educator or pastor, and have experience with or currently involved in the local church youth ministry program and/or in presbytery.
3. Be willing to care for, provide supervision, and assume responsibility for young people in our presbytery's delegation and in the larger Triennium community. This includes being particularly responsible for a small group of our youth. If needed, it may also involve disciplinary action.
4. Be willing to follow the same Triennium covenant guidelines that all Triennium youth follow and to assist with enforcing that covenant.
5. Be willing and able to participate in the total program and activities of the 2010 Youth Triennium and encourage full participation by others. This includes being physically able to accompany youth all over Purdue's campus.
6. Be able to travel with the delegation to and from the event, July 17-22, on chartered bus(es). If the need arises and we need to take additional mini-vans, possibly assist with driving (though this is not required).
7. Attend an adult orientation prior to the event and be present for an overnight orientation for the entire delegation on July 19, in Charleston.
8. Complete the necessary background checks in accordance with the "Statement of Purpose and Policy For Presbytery of West Virginia Events Involving Children, Youth and Persons with Disabilities."
9. Be at least 24 years of age by July 20, 2010.
