SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE PRESBYTERY OF WEST VIRGINIA

*(Grants and loans available for students in
academic or vocational courses of study.)*



THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND is used for grants for the education of dependent students in West Virginia, with preference given to those whose legal residence is Boone County. Maximum amount of grant is \$500. Grants may be renewed up to four years, if requested.

THE RINER FUND provides loans for Presbyterian Church (USA) students in the Presbytery of West Virginia, with preference for those attending Presbyterian Colleges. Loans are available for academic or vocational courses of study. The maximum amount of a loan is \$1000 per year. Loans may be renewed up to four years, if so requested. Loans are to be repaid beginning six months after graduation or termination of studies, unless a deferment is requested during graduate studies.

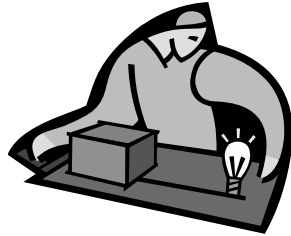

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE SYNOD OF THE TRINITY

(Applicant must be: permanent resident within the bounds of the Synod of the Trinity; a United States citizen or a permanent resident of the US; enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 24 credit hours per year, excluding summer schools) in an accredited undergraduate or vocational school.)

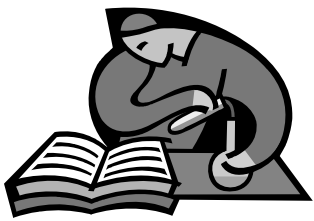


THE SYNOD OF THE TRINITY EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP assists full-time undergraduate students who are members of a PC(USA) church at any college, or students of any denomination attending one of the Synod related-colleges.

THE RUSCH-SHEPARD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP assists undergraduate students who are children of minimally-salaried Presbyterian Church (USA) pastors serving in the Synod of the Trinity.

THE RACIAL ETHNIC EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP assists full-time undergraduate students of any denomination who are African American, Hispanic/Latino, Middle Eastern or Native American.

SYNOD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS are available in October of each year at www.syntrinity.org. SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (USA)

NATIONAL PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP is for superior young students preparing to enter as full-time incoming freshmen in a participating college related to the PC(USA). Applicants must: be confirmed members of PC(USA); be high school seniors intending to enter college full-time; carry a 3.0 cumulative GPA from high school; take the SAT/ACT exam no later than Dec 15 of senior year; demonstrate financial need. *Deadline for applications is January 31* of senior year of high school.
