



INFORMATION SHEET

- Date:** Tuesday, July 20-Saturday, July 24, 2010 (with a mandatory Presbytery orientation in Charleston the night of Monday, July 19)
- Who:** Youth who will be 9th graders in the fall of 2010 through those who are no older than 19 years old on July 20, 2010. Adults who are at least 25 years old on July 20, 2010. Work Crew is for those who are 19-22 years old and is limited in registration. New this year is an opportunity for adults age 55 and over to serve as Triennium Ambassadors. There may be adults in your congregation who would like to apply to be Small Group Leaders; Small Group Leader Application Forms can be found on the Triennium website. Unlike in the past, there is no set number of participants that we can take. However, we must have one adult for every 10 young people. A particular church sending 8 or more youth is expected to provide at least one potential Adult Advisor.
- Theme:** “For Such a Time as This” from Esther 4:1. With these words of encouragement to be courageous, to be faithful and to be attentive to God will be developed throughout the week through daily presentations, worship, prayer, recreation and small groups. A theme guide can be found on the Triennium website.
- Location:** The Presbyterian Youth Triennium is held on the campus of Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana.
- Event Overview:** Triennium begins with registration and recreation on Tuesday, July 20, with worship and an opening night celebration following dinner. Each day will include small group discussion times, worship, prayer and recreation events, a spirituality center, an exhibit hall and free time. Triennium ends before noon on Saturday, July 24; our delegation will return to Charleston late that evening.
- Cost:** For youth participants the cost for the event is \$425 and for adult participants, \$125. This includes travel, housing, meals (with the exception of those while traveling), triennium and presbytery t-shirts, and registration fees. The **cost** per person will be \$425 per person for youth; \$125 per

person for adults and \$400 for Work Crew. This amount is expected to be paid in full for each person registered by February 22. If a person finds they are unable to go after that date, they may be replaced with another person of the same gender. However, if no replacement is found, funds are still required because we are required to pay them to Triennium based on the number of registrants we turn in by February 26. For youth, \$250 is due at the time of registration; the remainder is due by May 1. Adult Advisor applicants do not need to send money until they are notified whether they have been chosen to attend.

Travel: Our primary means of transportation will be chartered bus.
