SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Presbyterian Education Program Skills (PEPS) scholarships are intended to assist church professionals and lay leaders participate in leadership training and certification events through continuing education events; and to assist churches in carrying out leadership training. Ordinarily, PEPS funds will be allocated to cover no more than 1/3 of the total cost for those who receive little or no continuing education allowance and no more than 1/10 of the total cost for those who receive an allowance greater or equal to the presbytery's recommendation allowance for certified educators. Ministers of Word and Sacrament are encouraged to apply to for assistance from the Committee on Ministry.
