PRESBYTERY OF WEST VIRGINIA MEETING HIGHLIGHTS May 16, 2016

The Presbytery of West Virginia met on Thursday, May 16, 2016 at the **Bluestone Camp** and **Retreat, Hinton, WV.** The following are the highlights of the meeting.

Introduced Teaching Elders **Rebecca Mihm** (Pastor at **Fleming Memorial Presbyterian Church, Fairmont**) and **Rachel Shepherd** (Pastor at **Marlinton Presbyterian Church**) as new members of the Presbytery.

Heard from Teaching Elder **Rebecca Davis**, Assistant Professor of Religion at Presbyterian College, who presented a program on "**Protecting Our Children**." Rebecca will be back in West Virginia on September 10 to lead a Child Protection Policy workshop at **Village Chapel Presbyterian Church, Charleston**. Each session is now required by the Book of Order (G-3.0106) to have a Child Protection Policy for their church.

Worshiped: Teaching Elder Andy Rice (Pastor of the Oak Grove Presbyterian Church, Hillsboro) preached the sermon and Ruling Elder Mike Burton (Fayetteville Presbyterian Church) served as the liturgist. Teaching Elders Joan Stewart (Member-at-Large) and Chris Kilbert (Riverlawn, St. Albans) presided at the celebration of the Lord's Supper.

Received an offering for the **West Virginia Ministry of Advocacy and Workcamps** (WVMAW).

Approved the request of the Ministry Committee to appoint an Administrative Commission to work with the **First Presbyterian Church, Huntington**.

Celebrated the history of the **Brush Creek Presbyterian Church, Ridgeview** and voted to approve the request of the Administrative Commission, which had been working with the church to dissolve the congregation as of May 19, 2016.

Heard presentations from Teaching Elder **Nancy Didway** (**Highlawn, St. Albans**) on the presbytery's **Prayer Vision Initiative** and from **Mark Parsons-Justice** on the presbytery's **Communication Plan**.

Elected Jim Musgrave (**Highlawn, Huntington**) to serve on the Leadership Team, **James Rowe** (**Old Stone**) to serve on the Trustees and as its chair, **Mike George** (**Community**) to serve on the Mission Committee and **Larryetta Ellis** (**Edgewood**) as the Chair of the Mission Committee, **Bob Bondurant** (**HR**) to serve on the Permanent Judicial Commission, and **Carlene Rose** (**Ripley**) to serve on the Relations Committee.

Learned that 42 men representing 12 churches participated in the **Guy's Weekend** and 30 people representing six churches participated in the **Spring Getaway** at **Bluestone**. Primary summer leadership and counseling staff have been hired. Summer staff training

will begin on June 3. The first camper session will begin on June 12 and run Sunday to Saturday for four weeks concurrently.

Received an overview of the three different kind of grants (**Mission Grants, Brick and Mortar Grants, Hunger Action Grants**) that are accessed through the work of the Mission Committee as well as a sample copy of the **Mission Grant Application**, which is due by October 11, 2016.

Learned that the presbytery had spent \$147,074.78 of its 2016 budget of \$837,424.00 (or 17.65) from January through March of this year.
