

Retreat Focus: How can a more literary understanding of the Bible enrich the life of faith communities?

Every part of the Bible was originally a popular literary work during a long era when words were the main entertainment and form and content were closely connected, meaning religious ideas were fused to literary devices. The retreat will explore how to accessibly and congenially present a sense of the Bible as literature that can guide and inspire modern Christians.

Leader: Sarah Ruden holds a Harvard doctorate in Latin and Greek and an M.A. from the Johns Hopkins Writing Seminars. She studied Hebrew at Yale Divinity School, has taught and lectured widely, and is now a visiting research fellow at the University of Pennsylvania. She has published nine books, including *Paul Among the People: The Apostle Reinterpreted and Reimagined in His Own Time* (Pantheon, 2010) and *The Face of Water: A Translator on Beauty and Meaning in the Bible* (Pantheon, 2017). She is currently completing a new translation of the Gospels for the Modern Library. Sara is committed to peacemaking across cultural divides and is a frequent guest in venues as diverse as the US Naval Academy, the 92nd Street YMCA in Manhattan, and Catholic and evangelical churches.
