

POST-SECONARDY LOANS and GRANTS

AVAILABLE THROUGH THE PRESBYTERY OF WEST VIRGINIA



(**Grants and Loans** are available for students in academic or vocational courses of study.)



THE RINER FUND provides loans for Presbyterian Church (USA) students in the Presbytery of West Virginia, with preference for those attending Presbyterian Colleges. Loans are available for academic or vocational courses of study. The maximum amount of a loan is \$1000 per year. Loans may be renewed up to four years, if so requested. Loans are to be repaid beginning six months after graduation or termination of studies, unless a deferment is requested during graduate studies.

THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND is used for grants for the education of dependent students in West Virginia, with preference given to those whose legal residence is Boone County. While the maximum amount per grant is \$500, the ability to offer these, and their amounts, varies each year

Applications and Requests for Renewals must be received in the Presbytery Office no later than April 30 for the next academic year.
